Blue Ridge Parkway Communities and North Cove:

Located in this trail area, is a NC Century Farm operating a retail shop, English Farmstead Cheese. Pick

up treats to enjoy on the ride or at your destination. Open Friday/Saturday.

Next, check out a unique disc golf course, the North Cove Social Club. This new public course will surprise



you! The next stop is neighboring Linville Caverns. These are North Carolina's only public caverns.

As you approach the Linville Falls Winery, you'll pass an entry point for the Blue Ridge Parkway. Consider a detour before or after this stop. The Parkway section between Linville Falls and Crabtree Falls is stunning. It includes the seasonal community of Little Switzerland.

Marion, Old Fort, Lake James:

Five of our twelve stops are located inside downtown Marion. Park the car and spend time tasting your way

through this fun section of town.

Lake James and the two
Lake James State Parks offer
biking and hiking trails,
campgrounds, a swimming
beach, and canoe/kayak
rentals. When stopping by
Mica Town Brewing Nebo
and Fonta Flora Brewery,
spend a few hours by the lake.


